STEAM-Greg/Kelly

- From Greg: STEAM orientation went well and provided all links to lessons and had bots out for volunteers to see. Lots of interest and volunteers attending. Lots of volunteers already coordinating dates for STEAM challenges. Lessons and materials for STEAM challenges are available. Incorporating a 3D printing element to include in the challenges. Ms. Harris is using Mouse Kits to incorporate in her classroom to use the 3D printer and her parent volunteers have started experimenting. Wednesday morning Open Hours in Maker Space has been popular with volunteers coming to play with devices, talk and collaborate. Organizing Maker Space to get computers and robots organized.

- Great core team that's working hard and it's been helpful to get everything moving. Focused on 1st and 2nd grade with assigned volunteers. Some started this week and more will start next week. Trained new volunteers on the 20th who got to observe and will start next week. Working on scheduling with 5th grade classes. Had 14 volunteers scheduled so far – some are community volunteers, and some are Dingeman parents. Will plan another training and outreach soon. UTK and Kinder discussions with teachers on what would work for them.
